## **2019-2020 Public School Open Enrollment Timeline**

The application period for open enrollment runs from February 4 through April 30, 2019.

- In-district open enrollment forms (residents of the Fond du Lac School District only) can be obtained during the enrollment window at any elementary or middle school in our district, or at the Administration Center at 72 W. 9th Street. Continuing Rosenow students need not reapply.

## **Kindergarten Registration**

5 year-old Kindergarten registration dates have been set for children who will be attending the Fond du Lac School District during the 2019-2020 school year.

Registration will begin on Monday, April 8, 2019, and will continue through Friday, April 12, 2019.

During April 8<sup>th</sup> – April 12<sup>th</sup>, parents of prospective kindergartners can register their child between 9:00 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. Parents are also asked to bring proof of their child's age in the form of a birth certificate or baptismal record when registering. The original document will be returned to you.

Wisconsin statutes state, "Except as provided in s.115.01(2) and s.115.28(8), no child may be admitted to kindergarten unless he or she is 5 years old on or before September 1, in the year he or she proposes to enter school." Children reaching their 5<sup>th</sup> birthday after September 1, but on or before December 1 may be admitted to kindergarten upon Administrative approval according to School Board Policy. Requests for early entrance should be addressed to the Director of Pupil Services, 920-906-6520.

Since the 2012-13 school year, 118.33(6)(cm) prohibits a school board or an independent charter school under Wis. Stat. Sec. 118.40(2r) from enrolling a child in first grade unless the child has completed 5-year-old kindergarten or has received an exemption.

# Taste the Rainbow

A fruit and vegetable challenge.

**What:** Rosenow students will be challenged to eat more fruits and vegetables by sampling a different fruit or vegetable each day for one week.

**When:** March 4-8, 2019

**Who:** All students in grades 4K-5th grade at Rosenow

**Why:** March is National Nutrition Month. This nutrition challenge is a great reminder for us to make sure we are getting 5 servings of fruits and vegetables every day, and in a rainbow of colors. Hopefully students will find one or more foods they like, too!
