

FHS SCRIP INFO

Fond du Lac High School is participating in the Scrip Network with Woodworth Middle School again this year. For those not familiar with the program, Scrip is an ongoing fundraiser (yes, that dreaded word!). However, unlike most fundraisers, Scrip does not actually cost you anything extra. You purchase gift certificates or gift cards for the stores where you regularly shop, and you use these certificates instead of cash when you shop. The stores sell the certificates to our school at a discount, and the difference between our purchase price and the face value is profit for our school. We keep track of profits, and families are able to use 80% of the profit *they* have brought in to pay their kids' school fees (athletic fees, field trips, yearbook, registration fees, etc.). The remaining 20% of the profit is used by the school.

The program is simple. Check over the order form and find stores where you usually shop. Fill in the amounts of the certificates you want to order, and enclose a check for the amount of your total order. The "profit" that we make is the percentage shown next to each vendor on the order form. The more you use Scrip, the more FHS will earn in profits, and the more you will have in your family account to pay your kids' fees! Profits not used this year will carry over to next year. If you do not have kids in school, you may choose to have 100% of your profits used for FHS, or you could use your profits to purchase your yearbook!

Orders are taken weekly and are due to Kathy Jones in the office by 3:30 p.m. on Fridays. The Scrip certificates you ordered will be available for pickup from Kathy Jones on the following Thursday.
