

Fond du Lac High School Parking Lot Rules

The lot regulations will be enforced by Section 346.55 Wisconsin Statutes.

- A. Cars must be properly registered.
- B. Parking tag must be hung on the rear view mirror.
- C. Cars must be parked legally -- within the parallel lines.

Rules for Student Parking

- 1. Permit tags are required.
- 2. Careless / reckless driving will not be permitted. Please stay only on hard surfaces.
- 3. Smoking is not permitted anywhere on school property including in any vehicle.
- 4. No illegal narcotics, alcohol, or weapons are allowed in your vehicle.
- 5. Vehicles are not to be used as lounging areas.
- 6. Vehicles should be locked.
- 7. NO LITTERING.
- 8. Students must park in student assigned areas and may not park in "Visitor" stalls.
- 9. Lots A, B & C are available to all students. Lot D is staff parking only.
- 10. Students must obey all school rules.
- 12. Students must have a valid and current driver's license to apply for a permit.
- 13. Handicap parking stalls are to be used only for cars that have a legal handicap sticker or license plate.

Violations of the rules could result in fines, towing, and/or related costs according to Section 346.55 Wisconsin Statutes, as well as loss of parking privileges.

I understand that the parking lot is public property that is under the control of the Fond du Lac School District. I will prominently display the parking permit on the vehicle designated for access. I agree that the authorized vehicle will not be used to transport or store contraband of any kind, and I will not use the lot in any way that will violate the school district code of conduct or criminal law.

I hereby understand and give the administration of the Fond du Lac High School (or their designee) my consent to search the authorized vehicle when it is parked on school property.

As the responsible party for the vehicle, my signature on the parking permit application states that I hereby agree to the above-stated terms and responsibilities in connection with obtaining authorization to use the school parking facilities.
