

What's Happening in Grade 4?

Grade 4 is in the midst of Unit 2 of our math curriculum. In this unit, students will: multiply by 10, 100, and 1,000, multiply by 2-digit numbers, represent multiplication equations with ratio tables and arrays, divide with and without remainders, and solve multiplication and division story problems.

In writing, grade 4 is celebrating the end of the first unit by publishing realistic fiction stories! Fourth graders worked to add more to the heart of the story including not only actions and dialogue, but also thoughts and feelings; showing why characters did what they did.

THE GRADE LEVEL SCREENERS WILL BE ADMINISTERED TO YOUR CHILD BY THE END OF DECEMBER AND THE RESULTS WILL BE SHARED THROUGH TEACHER COMMUNICATION AND/OR PARENT TEACHER CONFERENCES.

Sick Student Protocol

Since we are now in the cold and flu season, we would like to review with you several points regarding sick children at school. Healthy children are the best learners so we want everyone to be as healthy as possible.

If your child is sick, please keep them at home. Sometimes you may be unsure whether you should send your child to school or not. Some reasons you should probably keep your child at home include:

- Oral temperature above 100.0, or has had a temperature above 100.0 in the past 24 hours.
- Coughing frequently or has a productive cough (is coughing up phlegm).
- Had diarrhea or vomiting in the past 24 hours.
- Is complaining that his/her ears or throat hurt.
- Is very tired because of being up during the night with any of the above symptoms.
- Is just "not feeling good" or is acting sluggish.

We use the 24 hour rule. No fever, vomiting, and/or diarrhea for 24 hours before attending school.

If your child develops signs of illness at school, you or your emergency contact(s) will be contacted to come and take them home. Please make every effort to pick up your child within the hour. Roberts has a nurse 1-2 days a week. You will be contacted by the secretary on days the nurse is not here.

Dado que estamos en la temporada de resfriados y gripe, nos gustaría repasar con ustedes varios puntos relacionados con los niños enfermos en la escuela. Los niños sanos son los mejores estudiantes, por eso queremos que todos estén lo más sanos posible.

Si su hijo está enfermo, manténgalo en casa. A veces es posible que no esté seguro de si debe enviar a su hijo a la escuela o no. Algunas razones por las que probablemente deberías dejar a tu hijo en casa incluyen:

Temperatura oral superior a 100,0, o ha tenido una temperatura superior a 100,0 en las últimas 24 horas.

Tose con frecuencia o tiene tos productiva (está tosiendo con flema). Ha tenido diarrea o vómitos en las últimas 24 horas.

Se queja de que le duelen los oídos o la garganta.

Está muy cansado por estar despierto durante la noche con cualquiera de los síntomas anteriores.

Simplemente "no se siente bien" o actúa con lentitud.

Usamos la regla de las 24 horas. No tener fiebre, vómitos y/o diarrea durante las 24 horas anteriores a asistir a la escuela.

Si su hijo presenta signos de enfermedad en la escuela, se comunicará con usted o su(s) contacto(s) de emergencia para que lo lleven a casa. Por favor haga todo lo posible para recoger a su hijo dentro de una hora. Roberts tiene una enfermera 1 o 2 días a la semana. La secretaria se comunicará con usted los días que la enfermera no esté aquí.
