Dismissal Cool Tool

Expectations: Be Respectful, Be Responsible, Be Safe

Objective: To wait in designated areas for buses, vans, and cars after school.

Expectations	Specifics
Be Respectful	Stay in line and talk quietly while waiting for your ride or bus to come
Be Responsible	 Stand on the sidewalks in your designated area Van riders stand on the right side of the sidewalk Bus riders stand in two separate lines (Nichols on the right and Johnson on the left side) Car riders stand on the left side of the sidewalk Stay within the yellow lines in the parking lot
Be Safe	 All students are on sidewalks with backpacks and hands to themselves Grass and garden areas are off limits Look both ways when in the parking lot

Activities:

Model-Presenter demonstrates positive behavior in all areas using examples and NON-examples.

Be Respectful--Demonstrate staying in line and talking quietly while waiting for your bus or ride to come.

Be Responsible--Demonstrate correct areas on the sidewalk/parking lot for bus, van, and car riders to stand.

Be Safe--Demonstrate all students on sidewalks keeping backpacks and hands to themselves. Look both ways when in the parking lot.

Classroom Teaching Activities/Instruction:

- 1. Classroom teacher specific areas where students need to wait to be picked up after school.
- 2. Classroom teacher will review behavioral expectations for dismissal for waiting after school.
- 3. If students are unable to demonstrate appropriate after school behavior, the classroom teacher will practice expectations with individual students.

Building Wide Follow-Up/Reinforcement Activities:

- 1. Verbally praise students who follow after school bus/van/car rules.
- 2. Distribute Wildcat Cash to students who follow after school bus/van/car rules.
