K/1 DROP OFF/PICK UP LANE

Families- We need your help!

If you have a Kindergarten or Grade 1 student, please follow the procedures below for drop off and pick up. We are concerned about safety in the parking lot area.

-Use the drop off lane for dropping off or picking up only. **Do not park in the lane or get out of your car.**

-Use the driving lane for leaving the drop off/pick up lane. We cannot have cars parking in either lane for safety reasons.

-If you are getting out of your car, please park on the street in an area where parking is legal (avoid the no parking signs in some areas). Due to the large number of children crossing the drop off lane traffic, we cannot have families parking in the staff parking lot.

General Information

Kindergarten: Students will perform at 1:00 pm alongside the choir in the Roberts gym.

First and Second Grade: Students will perform at 1:45 pm alongside the choir in the Roberts gym.

Choir: Students will perform at both the 1:00 pm and 1:45 pm programs. Both of their performances will be the same. They will need to stay at school for the second performance, so it is my recommendation that you come to the second performance if you would like to take them home with you immediately following the performance.

Concert Attire

Students are encouraged to wear whites and blues to the concert to emulate a snowy day. If you don't have white or blue, that is okay! All students will sing regardless, this is not an area I want anyone to stress about.

After the Concert

If you wish to bring your student home following the concert, you will be able to pick your child up in their classroom following the concert. Please do not attempt to get your child from the gym immediately following the performance or during any of the performances, we ask that you wait until the conclusion of the full performance. All students will be sent back to their home classrooms at the conclusion of the program. This is when you will be able to check your students out from their classrooms. At that time, you can also pick up any siblings who were not in the program from their home classroom. There will be no need to check out at the office!

Sick Student Protocol

Since we are now in the cold and flu season, we would like to review with you several points regarding sick children at school. Healthy children are the best learners so we want everyone to be as healthy as possible.

If your child is sick, please keep them at home. Sometimes you may be unsure whether you should send your child to school or not. Some reasons you should keep your child at home include:

- Oral temperature above 100.0, or has had a temperature above 100.0 in the past 24 hours.
- Coughing frequently or has a productive cough (is coughing up phlegm).
- Had diarrhea or vomiting in the past 24 hours.
- Is complaining that his/her ears or throat hurt.
- Is very tired because of being up during the night with any of the above symptoms.
- Is just "not feeling good" or is acting sluggish.
- **Covid + students must isolate for 5 days from the start of symptoms**

We use the 24 hour rule. No fever, vomiting, and/or diarrhea for 24 hours before attending school.

If your child develops signs of illness at school, you or your emergency contact(s) will be contacted to come and take them home. Please make every effort to pick up your child within the hour. Roberts has a school nurse 1-2 days a week. You will be contacted by the secretary on days the nurse is not here.

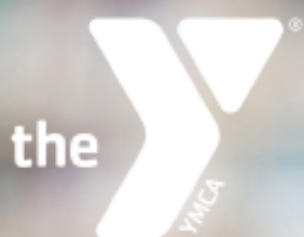

Protocolo de estudiante enfermo

Dado que estamos en la temporada de resfriados y gripe, nos gustaría repasar con ustedes varios puntos relacionados con los niños enfermos en la escuela. Los niños sanos son los mejores estudiantes, por eso queremos que todos estén lo más sanos posible.

Si su hijo está enfermo, manténgalo en casa. A veces es posible que no esté seguro de si debe enviar a su hijo a la escuela o no. Algunas razones por las que debería mantener a su hijo en casa incluyen:

Temperatura oral superior a 100,0, o ha tenido una temperatura superior a 100,0 en las últimas 24 horas.

Tose con frecuencia o tiene tos productiva (está tosiendo con flema).

Ha tenido diarrea o vómitos en las últimas 24 horas.

Se queja de que le duelen los oídos o la garganta.

Está muy cansado por estar despierto durante la noche con cualquiera de los síntomas anteriores.

Simplemente "no se siente bien" o actúa con lentitud.

Estudiantes Covid+ deberán aislarse durante 5 días desde el inicio de síntomas

Usamos la regla de las 24 horas. No tener fiebre, vómitos y/o diarrea durante las 24 horas anteriores a asistir a la escuela.

Si su hijo presenta signos de enfermedad en la escuela, se comunicará con usted o su(s) contacto(s) de emergencia para que lo lleven a casa. Por favor haga todo lo posible para recoger a su hijo dentro de una hora. Roberts tiene una enfermera escolar 1 o 2 días a la semana. La secretaria se comunicará con usted los días que la enfermera no esté aquí.
