Sick student protocol

Since we are in cold and flu season, we would like to review with you several points regarding sick children at school. Healthy children make the best students, so we want everyone to be as healthy as possible.

If your child is sick, keep him or her home. Sometimes you may not be sure whether you should send your child to school or not. Some reasons you should keep your child home include:

- Oral temperature greater than 100.0, or has had a temperature greater than 100.0 in the last 24 hours.
- You cough frequently or have a productive cough (you are coughing up phlegm).
- Have had diarrhea or vomiting in the last 24 hours.
- Complains that your ears or throat hurt.
- You are very tired from being awake during the night with any of the above symptoms.
- He just "doesn't feel right" or acts slowly.
- Covid+ students must isolate themselves for 5 days from the onset of symptoms. Testing is no longer mandatory for sick students.

We use the 24 hour rule. Not have fever, vomiting and/or diarrhea during the 24 hours before attending school.

If your child shows signs of illness at school, you or your emergency contact(s) will be contacted to take your child home. Please make every effort to pick up your child within one hour.

If you need to change your emergency contact information, please contact the school office. Emergency contacts can be viewed in your Family Access account.

The majority of crashes in our region involving a person walking or riding a bike occur at intersections and driveways. Stay alert while driving.

BEFORE SCHOOL CARE PROGRAM INFORMATION

FOND DU LAC FAMILY YMCA

PROGRAM GOAL:

Our goal is to provide before school care for families who are in need of early morning care.

WHAT DOES THE BEFORE SCHOOL CARE PROGRAM LOOK LIKE?

School is a safe environment for your child(ren) to engage with classmates before the start of the day. This program offers small activities such as coloring, games, books, and time to finish/get help with homework.

IS BREAKFAST INCLUDED?

We do not serve breakfast.

BEFORE SCHOOL PROGRAM SCHEDULE:

6:30 am until school starts

WHAT HAPPENS WHEN SCHOOL IS CANCELLED?

When school is cancelled or delayed, the BEFORE SCHOOL CARE PROGRAM will be cancelled. Refunds WILL NOT be issued due to cancellations.

PAYMENT METHOD; FEE IS \$180 PER MONTH PER CHILD

Payment will be collected through a monthly bank draft on the 1st of every month. If you are using Wisconsin Shares you are responsible for transferring payment; any remaining balance is your responsibility.

PROGRAM STAFF

Our BEFORE SCHOOL CARE PROGRAM is led by qualified, caring staff who are able to help children with homework, keep them engaged in games, and encourage their creativity. All staff must pass a background check prior to employment.

Protocolo de estudiante enfermo

Dado que estamos en la temporada de resfriados y gripe, nos gustaría repasar con ustedes varios puntos relacionados con los niños enfermos en la escuela. Los niños sanos son los mejores estudiantes, por eso queremos que todos estén lo más sanos posible.

Si su hijo está enfermo, manténgalo en casa. A veces es posible que no esté seguro de si debe enviar a su hijo a la escuela o no. Algunas razones por las que debería mantener a su hijo en casa incluyen:

- Temperatura oral superior a 100,0, o ha tenido una temperatura superior a 100,0 en las últimas 24 horas.
- Tose con frecuencia o tiene tos productiva (está tosiendo con flema).
- Ha tenido diarrea o vómitos en las últimas 24 horas.
- Se queja de que le duelen los oídos o la garganta.
- Está muy cansado por estar despierto durante la noche con cualquiera de los síntomas anteriores.
- Simplemente "no se siente bien" o actúa con lentitud.
- **Estudiantes Covid+ deberán aislarse por 5 días desde el inicio de síntomas. Las pruebas ya no son obligatorias para los estudiantes enfermos.**

Usamos la regla de las 24 horas. No tener fiebre, vómitos y/o diarrea durante las 24 horas anteriores a asistir a la escuela.

Si su hijo presenta signos de enfermedad en la escuela, se comunicará con usted o su(s) contacto(s) de emergencia para que lo lleven a casa. Por favor haga todo lo posible para recoger a su hijo dentro de una hora.

Si necesita cambiar su información de contacto de emergencia, comuníquese con la oficina de la escuela. Los contactos de emergencia se pueden ver en su cuenta de Family Access.

La mayoría de los choques en nuestra región donde hay un peatón o una persona en bicicleta se producen en los cruces y en los accesos de vehículos. Esté atento mientras maneja.
