## **CLASS 1 LEGAL NOTICE**

## FOND DU LAC SCHOOL DISTRICT STUDENT NONDISCRIMINATION

It is the policy of the Fond du Lac School District, pursuant to §118.13 and §111.31-§111.395, Wis.
